- Top 4 teams in each group to knockout stages.
- Top team from each group to quarter finals.
- One 2nd placed team drawn to quarter finals, the remaining two 2nd place teams and 3rd and 4th place teams drawn in preliminary quarter finals.
- Preliminary quarter final winners drawn to play 4 quarter final teams, avoid repeat pairings where possible. Teams ranked highest in the group stages have home advantage in the Pre-Quarter final.
- Semifinals open draw.
- All group games are home and away. In the event of the home venue not being available home team travel to opponents' venue or other nominated venue.
- Winner on the day in all knockout games up to and including Semi Finals & Final Replay.
- Structure of 2026 competition with club first teams playing Premier Junior (Named CUP) for 2026. Best placed 8 club second teams playing in new Reeves cup 2026 with 4 club second teams from intermediate 2025.



• The remaining teams play in **revised Junior A** for 2026 with teams from Junior B to make 12 team competitions for 2026.

Junior B, C & D

- 12 Teams 2 groups x 6 teams
- Top 4 teams in each group to Quarter finals
- 1A V 4B, 2A V 3B, 3A V 2B, 4A V 1B.
- All group games are home and away. In the event of home venue not being available, the home team travels to opponents' venue or other nominated venue.
- Winner on the day in all knockout games up to and including Semi Finals & Final Replay.
- Teams regraded to higher grades for 2026 competition to align with new structures.
